

NOTICE OF RACE



IZOLA - SLOVENIA
19.7.2025 - 25. 7. 2025



1. RULES

- 1.1. The Championship will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. National Authority prescriptions will not apply.
- 1.3. In all rules governing this championship:
 - 1.3.1. [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1.
 - 1.3.2. [SP] denotes a rule which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee without a hearing, or a discretionary penalty applied by the International Jury with a hearing.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. Sailing Instructions will be available during registration at the Championship website.
- 2.2. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The championship is open to all boats of the International Flying Junior Class that meet with the obligations of the Class Rules and their National Authority, in the case that a National Authority exists.
- 3.2. Slovenian competitors must be members of Slovenian Sailing Federation. For all other competitors either prove that he or she belongs to a World Sailing MNA. Online entry is possible through www.zoa.si/sailing/fjec2025
- 3.3. Complete entry deadline: 21 July 2025. A complete entry is when the payment of the applicable fee has been done. The applicable fee is the fee at the time of payment as per the fee scheme.
- 3.4. It will be possible to perform an entry after the deadline only with the Organizing Committee agreement.
- 3.5. All competitors (helmsman and crew) shall comply with the WS Eligibility Code.
- 3.6. Final registration is subjected to the presentation of following documents:
 - the check-in report form duly signed,
 - the disclaimer form duly signed,
 - a valid measurement certificate,
 - a valid third-party liability insurance (minimum 1.500.000 Euro),
 - the parent consent form for under 18 years old participants,
 - the completed equipment measurement form duly signed by the measurer of the event at the end of the measurement/inspection procedure.

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entry fee per boat, to be paid by bank transfer at SI56 0243 8026 5768 888 BIC LJBAS12X bank account registered to ZOA.SI
- 4.2. The reason of payment shall report the following: "FJ EC 2025_sail number of the boat_ full name of the helmsman".
- 4.3. Entry fees scheme:

- 4.4. Entry fees are not refundable.

5. ADVERTISING

- 5.1. [NP][DP] Boats may be required to display bow numbers and/or advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority, according to WS Appendix 20. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

- 6.1. A total of 12 races are scheduled for the IFJ European Championship.
- 6.2. No more than 4 races may be sailed each day.
- 6.3. The scheduled time of the first warning signal for IFJ European Championship is 13:00 hours on Tuesday, 22 July.
- 6.4. Last possible warning signal on Friday, 25 July is at 16:00 hours.

- 6.5. A minimum of 4 races must have been completed to constitute an IFJ European Championship series.
- 6.6. Information about further social events dates and venues will be posted on the official website.

7. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 7.1. Each boat shall present a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2. All boats will be checked for compliance with the Class Rules.
- 7.3. Measurement will take place as scheduled in the program.
- 7.4. Measurement checks may be carried out at any time during the event.

8. VENUE

- 8.1. The Flying Junior European Championship will be held in Izola, Slovenia, on July 19 - 25, 2025. The venue address and contacts:

- 8.2. Appendix 1 shows the location of the racing area.

9. THE COURSES

- 9.1. The courses will be triangular or windward/leeward.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1. Appendix P of the RRS "Special procedures for Rule 42" will apply.
- 10.2. Appendix T of the RRS "Arbitration" will apply.
- 10.3. An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS Appendix N.
- 10.4. The decisions of the Jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.3(a).

11. SCORING

- 11.1. Twelve (12) races are scheduled and the event will be valid if at least two (2) races will be finished.
- 11.2. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

- 11.3. When from 4 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4. When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 12.1. The entry form for support boats must be filled in and signed by the support boat responsible and must be approved by the Organizing Authority.
- 12.2. Entry deadline for support boats is 21 July at 10:00 hours.
- 12.3. The team coach boats shall conspicuously display their national flag and must comply with the coach boat regulations as defined in the Sailing Instructions. They must have a third-party liability insurance of € 1,500,000 worth.

13. CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

- 13.1. For chartered or loaned boats rule G3 will apply: a chartered or loaned boat may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules, provided that the race committee has approved her sail identification before the first race.

14. BERTHING

- 14.1. [NP][DP] Boats shall be placed exclusively inside the official area designated by the club.

15. TITLES AND PRIZES

- 15.1. The following titles will be awarded:
- Top 3 overall teams.
 - First Junior team.
 - Special prizes might be awarded

16. RISK STATEMENT

- 16.1. RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury.

- 16.2. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

17. ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

- 17.1. The Basic Principle is recalled, which states: "Participants are encouraged to minimize any adverse environmental impact of the sport of sailing"; it is recommended that care is taken to protect the environment at all times during and after the event. Especially, attention is drawn to RRS 47 -TRASH DISPOSAL- which states: "Competitors and support persons shall not intentionally put trash in the water. This rule applies at all times while afloat. The penalty for a breach of this rule may be less than disqualification".

18. INSURANCE

- 18.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000€ per incident or equivalent.

19. MEDIA RIGHTS

- 19.1. Competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and its Sponsors, without compensation, the perpetual right to make, use and show any text, motion pictures, video and still pictures, as well as live, taped or filmed television of, or relating to, the Championships.
